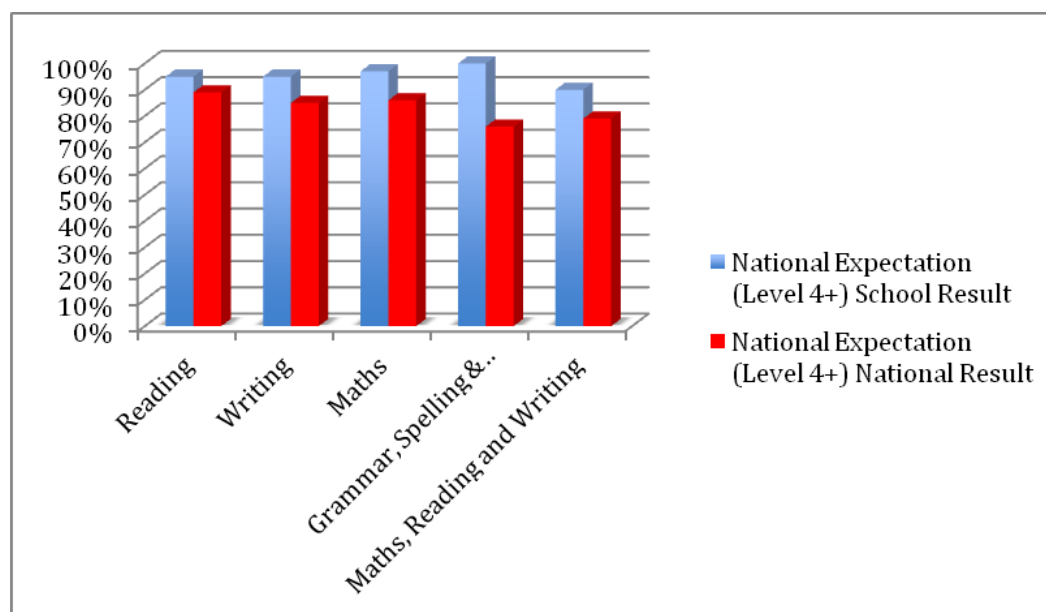


Key Stage 2 Results (SATs 2014)

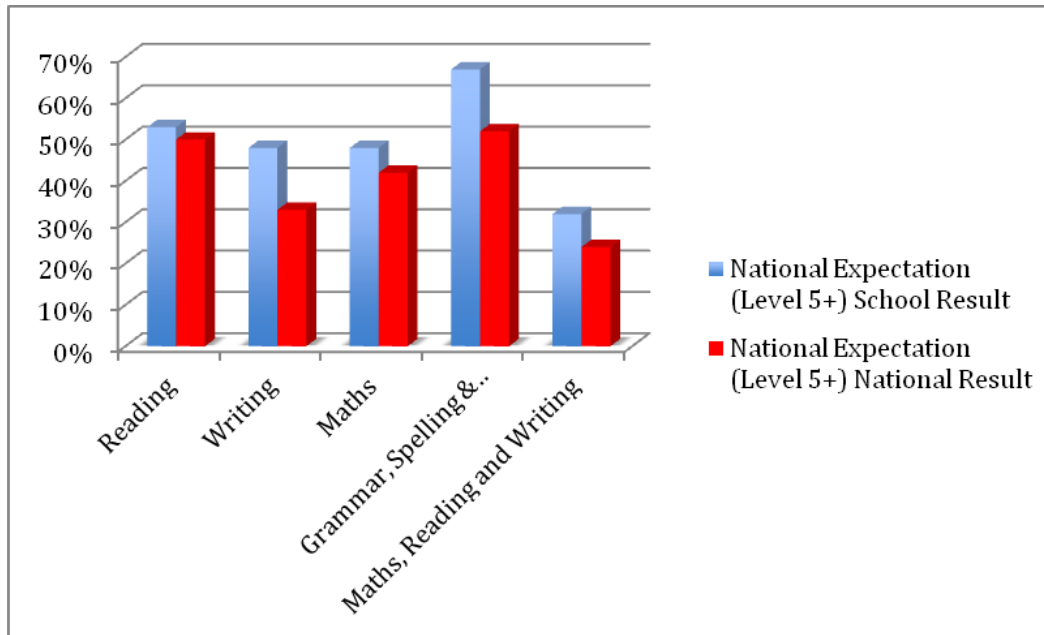
Level 4-school result versus national average

Reading-95% of pupils at the school achieved the national expectation of a level 4 against the national average of 89%. 53% of pupils achieved above national expectations and obtained a level 5 against the proposed national average of 50%.

Writing- 95% of pupils at the school achieved the national expectation of a level 4 against the national average of 85%. However 45% of pupils achieved above national expectations and obtained a level 5 against the national average of 33%. Two pupils achieved a level 6 equivalent to a 15 year old pupil.

Grammar, Spelling and Punctuation-This was the second year that the children sat this test and we were delighted that 100% of pupils at the school achieved the national expectation of a level 4 against the national average of 76%, 24% above which is fantastic. 67% of pupils achieved above national expectations and obtained a level 5 against the national average of 52%, which is an amazing achievement and statistically significant. Two pupils achieved a level 6 equivalent to a 15 year old pupil.

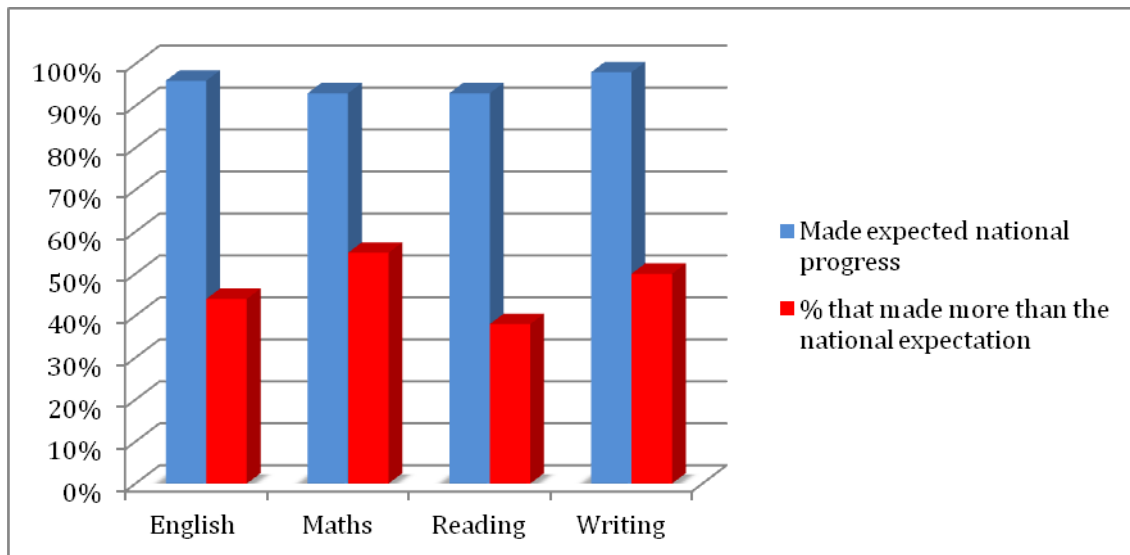
Maths-97% of pupils at the school achieved the national expectation of a level 4 against the national average of 86%. 48% of pupils excelled themselves and achieved above national expectations and obtained a level 5 against the national average of 42%. which is another incredible achievement and statistically significant. Six pupils achieved a level 6.

Reading, Writing, Maths-90% of pupils at the school achieved the national expectation of a level 4 against the national average of 79%. 32% of pupils achieved above national expectations and obtained a level 5 against the national average of 24%,

The school has performed above the national average in all areas, for level 4 and level 5, whilst also securing level 6 children. This is a magnificent achievement.
